The Conductor

Mark S. Kelly is director of bands and professor of music education at Bowling Green State University. A native of Centerville, Iowa, where he taught for 13 years as director of instrumental music, Mr. Kelly is a guest director, critic, and adjudicator for numerous festivals and contests throughout the United States. Prior to joining the Bowling Green Faculty in August 1966, he served one year as acting director of the University of Iowa Symphony and Hawkeye Concert Bands and supervisor for music education students doing practice teaching.

Mr. Kelly earned both the bachelor of arts and master of arts degrees from the University of Iowa in 1960 and 1962 respectively.

While he was at Centerville High School, the band was invited to appear at the Mid-West National Band Clinic in Chicago in 1957 and 1960. This clinic is the largest instrumental clinic of its kind in the United States and participation is invitational.

Under Mr. Kelly's guidance, the band program at Bowling Green State University has expanded from two concert bands and a marching band to six concert bands and a marching band. The *Symphonic Band*, conducted by Mr. Kelly, has appeared on many professional conference stages including the 1970 CBDNA North Central Division at DeKalb, IL; 1972 OMEA State Convention in Columbus, OH; 1976 CBDNA North Central Division at Bloomington, IN; and the 1978 MENC National Conference in Chicago, IL.

Mr. Kelly is a member of the American Bandmasters Association; College Band Directors National Association (president North Central Division 1978-80); Kappa Kappa Psi, band service fraternity; Music Educators National Conference; Ohio Music Educators Association; Omicron Delta Kappa (1972 Faculty Man of the Year); Phi Beta Mu, national bandmasters fraternity; and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, music fraternity (1978 Distinguished Teacher Award). In October, 1974, Mr. Kelly was honored in being selected as one of the Ten Most Outstanding Music Directors in the United States by the *School Musician Magazine*.
