

Dr James H Chandler, 1936-2006

DR. JAMES H. CHANDLER, 70, of Churubusco, passed away Sunday, Dec. 10, 2006. Born Nov. 7, 1936, in Indianapolis, he was the son of Howard and Betty (Hallett) Chandler.

He was a professor of music for 20 years, retiring in 2003. Before teaching at the college level he was the director of bands at several Indiana high schools including Warren Central High School from 1968 until 1978. Most recently he taught at Grace College, in Winona Lake.

He was a member of several professional music organizations and was still active in the music community, teaching private lessons and judging music competitions.

Surviving are his daughter, Darlene Chandler and her husband, Bob Schneider; son, William Chandler; sister, Marcia Phillips; grandchildren, Jennifer and Michael Chandler, and James Schneider; and several aunts and uncles. He was preceded in death by his wife, Mary L. Chandler.
